Scholarship Criteria

The Northwest Arkansas Chapter awards six \$1,000 scholarships to University of Arkansas juniors and seniors from Northwest Arkansas (Washington and Benton Counties). These scholarships are for the 2009-2010 academic year. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the chapter's annual Ice Cream Social prior to the fall semester.

Attendance is mandatory for recipients. Arrangements may be made to attend an alternate event upon approval by the executive committee of the chapter.

Minimum requirements to apply:

- Cumulative grade point average of 3.2
- 60 credit hours by the end of the Spring 2009 semester
- Permanent residence in Washington or Benton County
- Graduated high school in Washington or Benton County
- Full-time student

Financial need may also be considered as part of the selection.
